


CREATIVE AND COLORFUL IMPROV PIECING WORKSHOP

In this workshop the attendees will learn about what is Improv piecing and four improvisational piecing techniques (triangles, crosses, 1/4 circle and freestyle log cabin). I will help you to choose a beautiful color palette, that works perfect for this project and how to piece the quilt top in an organic way.

Materials Needed

- Masking tape
- Pencil
- Pins
- Fabric marker (erasable)
- Rotary cutter
- Quilting ruler
- Threads for sewing
- 16 fat quarters (solids or monochromatic printed fabrics) in 4 different analogous colors and 4 different values per color (4 colors x 4 different values = 16 fat quarters)
- Notebook and pencil for taking notes

Analogous colors are colors that are next to each other in the chromatic circle.

You can pick 4 analogous colors (Blue, Blue green, green, yellow green) and per each color 4 different values (Light-medium light-medium dark-dark)
